Instead of simply sending western scholars, western books, and westernstyled preaching to the Majority World, we seek to increase the number of biblically faithful scholars, books, and preachers emerging from local soil in Africa, Asia, Latin America, and the Middle East.

This amplification is needed now more than ever in countless global contexts as a growing number of churches are poised to bring life-transforming and lasting local change. Imagine parents, grandparents, students, young people, key community leaders listening to the faithful, clear, and relevant teaching and preaching of God's Word. A well-trained pastor, with solid and contextual biblical study resources in hand, can apply God's truth appropriately and insightfully to the village, the barrio, the favela, and everywhere God's Word needs to be heard now.

#### AMPLIFY!

Yet we should not stop at the borders of a faraway context. We ourselves have so much to learn from our sisters and brothers in the global church. Their insights, their perspectives, and their wisdom will enrich our own study of Scripture and help us to live more authentically "Coram Deo" – before the face of God. # **LANGHAM PREACHING** *Celebrating your impact*







**8,909 pastors trained** through **204** seminars in **54** countries in need of solid biblical teaching. During the pandemic, more than half of trainings were virtual. Praise God for the 99 Langham Preaching movements now in 85 countries!

**5,262 books sent free of charge** to participants at Langham Preaching seminars, including books like *Pastoral Preaching* by Conrad Mbewe and *Sweeter than Honey* by Chris Wright. These books help transform the preachers who transform lives with God's Word.

Langham founder John Stott said good preaching is impossible without good Bible study books. Your support provides pastors in a sensitive South Asian country with the books they need to teach the Bible well.

### LANGHAM LITERATURE

### Amplify the voices of indigenous biblical authors to strengthen the church

Langham supports indigenous theological writing and publishing so that pastors and leaders have access to books in their own language and context, helping them serve the unique needs in their communities. With your help, we develop books like the *Latin American Bible Commentary* that help leaders like Jocabed in Panama (pictured) biblically address issues like poverty, creation care, violence, and displaced people. As a missionary to her native Guna people, she says, "This tool can help indigenous pastors and leaders impact communities with the gospel and bring Latin American voices to all people."

180,249 books shipped around the world, including 16,563 Bible-centered books sent to 633 Majority World college libraries across 80 countries to help students grow and mature in Christ.

Your support sends books to seminary students like Sylvia in Myanmar, helping her prepare to share the gospel with her village.

**22 indigenous Christian publishers** supported in the production of 55 local-language titles

Because Langham supports Fount of Wisdom, a publisher in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, books make it into the hands of pastors and lay leaders in the surrounding village churches. Tim, the publishing director, says "The pastors cannot come to Bible school, but the books can come to them."

**13 local writers** in 12 countries received Writer Grants, enabling these leaders to write the books their cultures need.

Your support helped Paulos in Ethiopia write Son of God, which challenges the harmful prosperity gospel crippling the local church. He says, "Without Langham, this would've been impossible."

### Amplify the voices of scholars who impact nations

Your generosity trains leaders like Xiang\* from a sensitive part of Asia we call the "Big Country." Because of her PhD, she is a professor at a seminary in Hong Kong that trains leaders who will go on to shepherd the growing church across its borders. She says, "There's quite a need for trained pastors. My hometown church has 1,000 congregations but no fully trained pastors. I hope I can train more pastors for the mainland."

Charles Christian's studies prepare him to return to northern India to train leaders in a Bible college and develop biblical resources for the growing church in his nation.


**325+ Langham Scholars** are now serving around the world, starting vital new ministries, writing critically needed books, and multiplying trained leaders in their nations.

### FISCAL YEAR 2021

Langham Partnership is comprised of six national partners (Australia, Canada, Hong Kong, New Zealand, United Kingdom & Ireland, and the USA), each separately incorporated in its own nation with its own Board of Directors. Though each partner maintains separate financials, which are audited annually, there is full global transparency among all six partners. A global cloud accounting system enables oversight, analysis, and consolidation of the financials of the six members. This page offers the fuller consolidated global financial picture. Part of the fuller picture includes Langham USA helping with the fundraising and public communication aspects of the other members. Thus, the numbers shown for Langham USA reflect the costs of helping our national partners but not the income generated through that help. Not included in these financials are significant additional contributions from grassroots Langham organizations that uphold our vision and mission throughout the world.

The income and expense reported in this annual report are based on cash accounting whereas accrual accounting methods are used to report income in our audited statement and tax return; hence some differences may exist in comparison.
