Training pastors to faithfully and clearly preach the hope of Christ



MPACT OF LANGHAM-TRAINED PREACHERS

LANGHAM PREACHING // Celebrating your hope-filled impact



669 local trainers are leading Langham training events in 89 countries around the world.

Southeast Asian country traveled over 1,000 miles by plane, motorbike, and foot in October 2022 to train 25 pastors in a cold and remote area of the nation. With your support, well-trained pastors in a country currently under intense political and religious pressure are bringing God's Word to a people desperate for hope.

There are **1,104 groups of pastors** meeting around the world to assist and support each other in their Bible study and preaching skills.

Pastors and lay leaders met in April 2022 for their monthly Langham Preaching Club gathering in Manzini, Eswatini—a small, landlocked country in Southern Africa. Johannes Mngomezulu (standing center) says he was "hooked" on Langham from his first training. "Here in Eswatini there is more emphasis on the prosperity gospel. Langham brings a very simple model that helps us get back to the biblical truths that should be preached from the pulpit"

Your generosity led to **785,040 people** hearing God's Word proclaimed by a well-trained pastor.

Congregations throughout the islands of Fiji in the South Pacific sit under faithful Bible teaching thanks to your support and the work of Langham Preaching under the leadership of Tukana Nakesu. Mere Tora, a member of Tukana's church, says, "Pastor Tukana always finishes his sermons with how the text applies to our lives today. It makes an impact. God's Word is constant."

LANGHAM LITERATURE

Spreading hope through locally authored resources to help people understand and apply God's Word.

Langham supports indigenous theological writing and publishing so that pastors and leaders have access to books in their own language and context. These publishing projects help pastors in their region explore the Bible in greater depth and apply it to issues unique in their context.

15,878 courses in seminaries and colleges in the Majority World require books provided by Langham.

700 colleges and seminaries in 79 countries in the Majority World depend on Langham to supply books that help students grow and mature in Christ.

Distributed **236,622 Bible-centred books** to Majority World pastors, students, and ministry partners in need of study materials.

Your help put needed Bible study books into hands of pastors like Chukkrawut in Thailand. This book, written in his language and for his context, was published by Kanok Bannasan—a Thai Christian publisher that you helped support. Today, the book helps Pastor Chukkrawut shepherd his congregation to follow Jesus in a primarily Buddhist culture.

Helped **23 indigenous publishers** in 20 different countries produce 36 titles in local languages.

Thanks to your support, Langham published
Tackling Trauma—a book written by Christian
professionals from around the world to provide
practical responses to people's trauma, making it an
ideal resource for pastors, counselors, humanitarian
workers, and students. Roman Soloviy—a Regional
Commissioning Editor for Langham Literature—has
translated and published a Ukrainian edition of the
book. Roman says, "With this book we have a great
tool for Ukrainian pastors who will be able to provide
spiritual help for people who suffer from the war."

Funded work on 19 commentary projects led by local authors and editors.

Your support helps produce groundbreaking regional Bible commentaries like the Comentario Bíblico Contemporáneo—the first single-volume Bible commentary written entirely by Latin Americans for the Latin American church. The commentary is an indispensable tool in the hands of pastors like Mauricio Solís of Vida Abundante del Oeste in San José, Costa Rica. "When I read this commentary, it's like I put on the glasses of Latin America to read about Latin America, to preach to my Latin American context and needs. I don't have any other way to get information like this."

LANGHAM SCHOLARS

Equipping scholars who raise up leaders to bring hope to an entire nation.

Your generosity makes it possible to support emerging Christian leaders through PhD programs. These leaders return to their countries across Africa, Asia, Latin America, Eastern Europe, and the Middle East to shape their nations with a Biblical worldview.

Each scholar will directly train



Among other roles in the church and academia, Marie is caring for the least of these by researching justice issues related to the indigenous people in the Philippines and the online sexual exploitation of children.

Celebrated the **48 books and articles** published by Langham Scholars which will help people in their region gain better insights into God's Word.

Angukali Rotokha studied under Langham Scholar Havilah Dharamraj in a sensitive South Asian country. A Langham Scholar herself, Angukali serves as an Assistant Theological Editor for the upcoming South Asia Study Bible—an invaluable resource that will help pastors interpret and apply the Bible from a South Asian perspective—and is co-editing a textbook for Bible college and seminary students throughout Asia.

Impacted **109,695 students** who sat under the teaching of a Langham Scholar.

Langham Scholar Cesar Lopes (L) stands "shoulder to shoulder" with his former student, Diego. Diego now serves on the pastoral staff at several churches in some of the poorest neighborhoods in São Paulo, Brazil, bringing God's Word to some very hard places. Cesar, in addition to his in-person teaching, started an online seminary program that brings theological education to many Brazilians who could otherwise not access it.

FISCAL YEAR 2022

Langham Partnership is comprised of six national partners (Australia, Canada, Hong Kong, New Zealand, United Kingdom & Ireland, and the USA), each separately incorporated in its own nation with its own Board of Directors. Though each partner maintains separate financials, which are audited annually, there is full global transparency among all six partners. A global cloud accounting system enables oversight, analysis, and consolidation of the financials of the six members. This page offers the fuller consolidated global financial picture. Part of the fuller picture includes Langham USA helping with the fundraising and public communication aspects of the other members. Thus, the numbers shown for Langham USA reflect the costs of helping our national partners but not the income generated through that help. Not included in these financials are significant additional contributions from grassroots Langham organizations that uphold our vision and mission throughout the world.

The income and expense reported in this annual report are based on cash accounting whereas accrual accounting methods are used to report income in our audited statement and tax return; hence some differences may exist in comparison.
