## Langham Preaching

God’s Word coming to life in 66 countries and 10,000 preachers.

### Pastors trained

Thanks to your help, the number of pastors and lay preachers that are being equipped to teach God’s Word continues to grow. In addition to pastors and church leaders equipped through Langham seminars, Preachers Clubs, formed by local pastors, provide both community and support for pastors and vital, ongoing training.

### Sustainability

Many countries have begun covering their own training costs, including even reaching out to help others receive training. For example, Indonesian churches covered the expenses of pastors from neighboring Tiber to attend their training event.

### Church life & growth

Pastors, church leaders and congregations are growing in faith and multiplying their newfound knowledge of His Word. For example, 16 countries are holding their own local training programs to reach new communities.

Ten years ago, most books were written and published in the west and given to the Majority World. Today, through your support, we continue to foster the creation of needed texts by national writers and in translations for pastors in many minority languages. The Langham Literature program is another example of how your investment in God's truth has a multiplicative impact.

# Langham Scholars

Biblical scholars trained and released into influential leadership.

## Celebrating future leaders

In fiscal year 2011, we accepted 12 new Langham scholars with a calling to lead, teach and share the gospel in their nations. In addition, 14 Langham Scholars graduated, equipped to return to their home countries to teach and lead seminaries, pastor churches, train missionaries and reach influential positions of leadership in church and government. These scholars extend the reach of the scholar program to areas in China, Kenya, Hong Kong, India, Poland, Macedonia, South Africa, Malaysia, Myanmar, Greece and Bolivia.

## Innovating with new training

In June 2011, we initiated the **Langham Research and Training Seminar**. It brings together 13 Ph.D. scholars over the course of three weeks, once a year for four years. These scholars stay in residence at a university with an academic library, complete a research project; get paired with a senior academic mentor, and attend/teach a tailored seminar series. At the end of this period, they have upgraded skills and experience to operate as research supervisors. This develops not only the individual scholar, but has a substantial impact on the quality of Majority World Ph.D. programs.

## Influencing the global Church

We give thanks that God has allowed Langham Scholars to advance into senior roles of influence and leadership around the world. In this way, the spiritual shepherding of the Lord's people is shifting more and more to local leaders who are, in turn, training other local leaders. There are now more than 300 graduated Langham Scholars around the world in more than 80 countries who are part of this type of "spiritual multiplication."

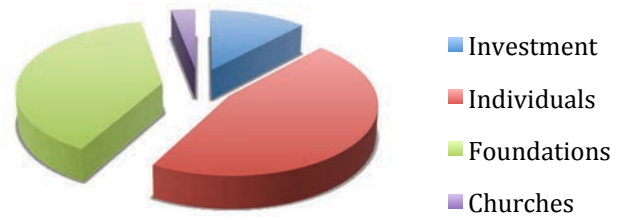

## Sources of income

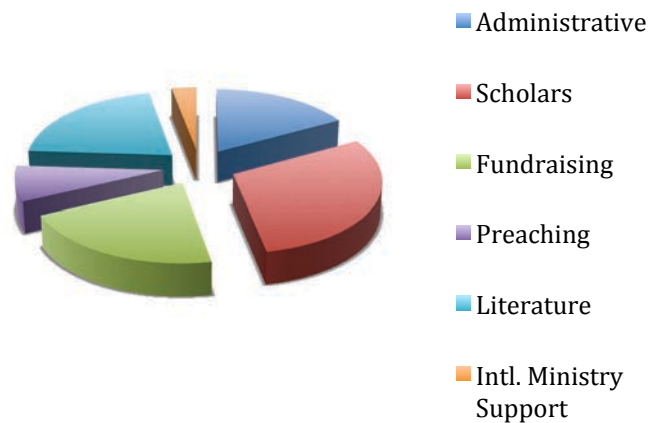
