Langham Preaching expanded to 100 countries.

A new work began in Madagascar in 2024. About 20 leaders from different denominations gathered to kick off the initiative. We pray for these local pastors and church leaders to catch the vision, spread the word and grow the movement in the years ahead.



There are 1,382 Langham preaching clubs around the world.

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the escuelitas (preaching clubs) movement in Colombia. 300+ people from across the country and around the region attended a refresher seminar in September. Also in Colombia, 17 young preachers began their journey through Langham's three-year curriculum with great hopes for fruit in their lives and future ministries.



1,116,080 people heard God's Word proclaimed by a well-trained pastor.

Langham Literature

You **MULTIPLIED** the publication of local authors who apply biblical truths to the daily realities of God's people around the world.

Langham supports theological writing and publishing throughout the Majority World so that pastors and leaders have access to books in their own language and context, helping them serve the unique needs in their communities. And this connection is vital. As one Langham-published author said, "There's a great need to show that the Bible is relevant to our context, because at the moment, historically, Christianity is viewed as Western."

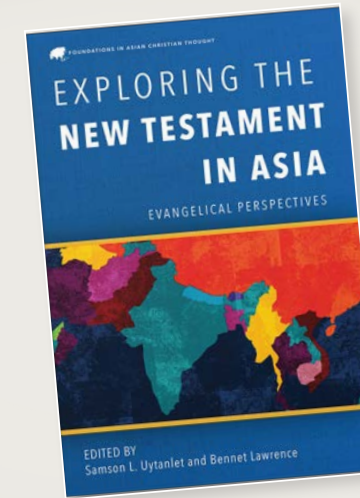
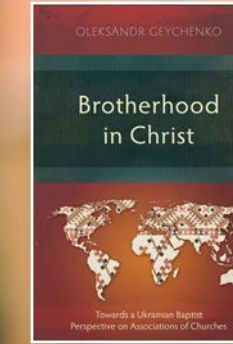

Helped **28** local publishers in **23** different countries produce **61** local language titles.

Oleksandr is a Langham Scholar, the rector of Odesa Theological Seminary in Odesa, Ukraine, and now a Langham-published author. Oleksandr, through his teaching and his book, applies gospel truth to a people and culture struggling with the ongoing ravages of war and its effects on their identity.



Published the groundbreaking, one-volume South Asia Bible Commentary in Urdu and advanced **14** other commentary projects.

In addition to developing ground-breaking regional commentaries, Langham also supports the development of other key regional resources like the "Foundations in Asian Christian Thought" series. The fourth book in the series, *Exploring the New Testament in Asia*, was published in 2024.

62% of institutions receiving Langham books are able to add a new degree program.

At the United Church of Zambia University, Langham-provided books enabled them to add a masters degree in theology. Pastor Saviour Kabaso Chipendano (far right, with two classmates)—part of the first class to graduate with that degree in April 2024—said, "Now I'm well equipped for the challenges that affect our people, our society, our nation and also me personally as a pastor. Graduating with a masters in theology means everything to me."





Kai is a Langham Scholar from a sensitive South Asian country. Thanks to the platform his PhD affords, he serves as the director of a seminary, writes needed books for his context and coordinates the Langham Preaching movement in his country—which just celebrated 20 years!*

Davi Manco, pictured with his wife and three children, is currently pursuing his PhD at Biola University with plans to return to their native Brazil. “I am confident that I am in a better place to support the Brazilian church to pursue a more efficient, biblically-grounded and research-based discipleship,” he says, “so that we can accomplish our Lord Jesus’ Great Commission more faithfully.”



Celebrated the graduations of **7** PhD scholars who joined **343+** graduated Langham Scholars serving around the world.

Rania Hendy (pictured left) is one of the 103 scholars supported in 2024. She completed her PhD in May and returned to Egypt where she is teaching at a seminary in Cairo amid rising Middle East tensions. “There are no words that can adequately express my abundant gratitude for Langham,” she said. “The investment you made in me will forever be remembered and cherished.”

Reached **115,730** students who learned from a Langham Scholar.

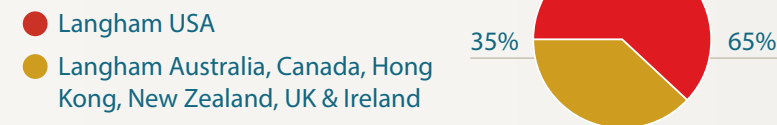

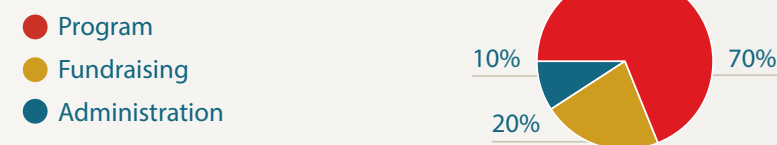
Fiscal Year 2024

Langham Partnership is comprised of six national partners (Australia, Canada, Hong Kong, New Zealand, United Kingdom & Ireland, and the USA), each separately incorporated in its own nation with its own Board of Directors. Though each partner maintains separate financials, which are audited annually, there is full global transparency among all six partners. A global cloud accounting system enables oversight, analysis and consolidation of the financials of the six members. This page offers the fuller consolidated global financial picture. Part of the fuller picture includes Langham USA helping with the fundraising and public communication aspects of the other members. Thus, the numbers shown for Langham USA reflect the costs of helping our national partners but not the income generated through that help. Not included in these financials are significant additional contributions from grassroots Langham organizations that uphold our vision and mission throughout the world.

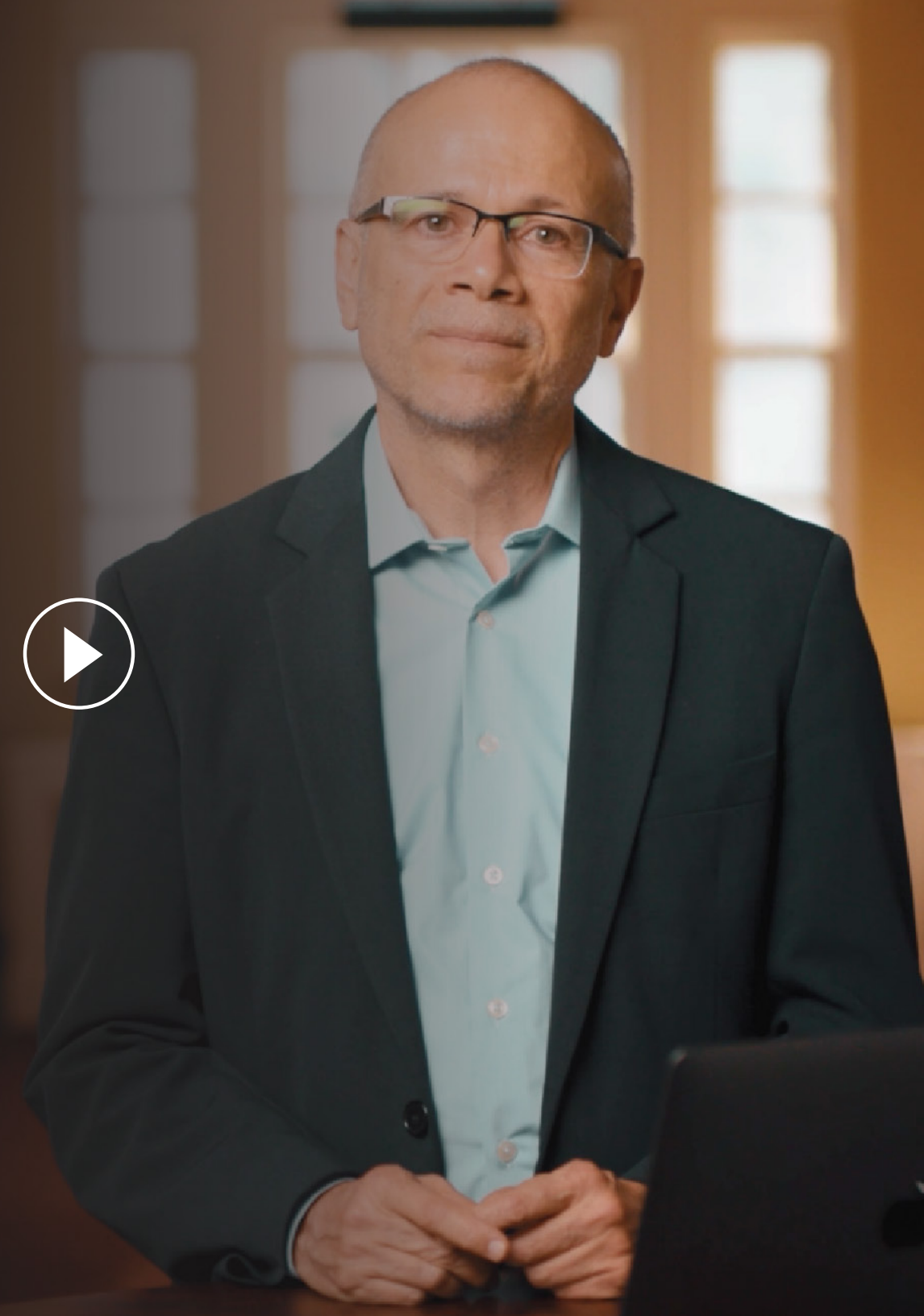
